28.309 Contract clauses for workers' compensation insurance.

- (a) The contracting officer shall insert the clause at $\underline{52.228-3}$, Workers' Compensation Insurance (Defense Base Act), in solicitations and contracts when the Defense Base Act applies (see $\underline{28.305}$) and-
- (1) The contract will be a public-work contract performed outside the *United States*; or
- (2) The contract will be approved or financed under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (Pub.L.87-195) and is not excluded by 28.305(b)(2).
- (b) The contracting officer shall insert the clause at $\underline{52.228-4}$, Worker's Compensation and War-Hazard Insurance Overseas, in solicitations and contracts when the contract will be a public-work contract performed outside the *United States* and the Secretary of Labor waives the applicability of the Defense Base Act (see $\underline{28.305}$ (d)).
