32.202-3 Conducting market research about financing terms.

Contract financing *may* be a subject included in the *market research* conducted in accordance with <u>part 10</u>. If *market research* for contract financing is conducted, the *contracting officer should* consider-

(a) The extent to which other buyers provide contract financing for purchases in that market;

(b) The overall level of financing normally provided;

(c) The amount or percentages of any payments equivalent to commercial advance payments (see <u>32.202-2</u>);

(d) The basis for any payments equivalent to *commercial interim payments* (see 32.001), as well as the frequency, and amounts or percentages; and

(e) Methods of liquidation of *contract financing payments* and any special or unusual payment terms applicable to *delivery payments* (see <u>32.001</u>).
