## **36.515 Schedules for construction contracts.**

The contracting officer may insert the clause at <u>52.236-15</u>, Schedules for *Construction* Contracts, in *solicitations* and contracts when a fixed-price *construction* contract is contemplated, the contract amount is expected to exceed the *simplified acquisition threshold*, and the period of actual work performance exceeds 60 days. This clause *may* also be inserted in such *solicitations* and contracts when work performance is expected to last less than 60 days and an unusual situation exists that warrants imposition of the requirements. This clause *should* not be used in the same contract with clauses covering other management approaches for ensuring that a contractor makes adequate progress.
