37.105 Competition in service contracting.

- (a) Unless otherwise provided by statute, contracts for services *shall* be awarded through sealed bidding whenever the conditions in 6.401(a) are met, (except see 6.401(b)).
- (b) The provisions of statute and $\underline{\text{part } 6}$ of this regulation requiring competition apply fully to *service contracts*. The method of *contracting* used to provide for competition may vary with the type of service being acquired and may not necessarily be limited to price competition.
