40.203-5 Exceptions.

The prohibitions in this section do not apply to the following (section 1832 of Pub. L. 118-31, $\underline{41}$ $\underline{U.S.C.}$ 3901 note prec.):

- (a) Wildfire management operations and search and rescue operations exception. The prohibitions in section 40.202 do not apply to an appropriate Federal agency to the extent that an authorized official at the agency, in consultation with the Secretary of Homeland Security, determines that the procurement or operation is necessary for the purposes of supporting the full range of wildfire management operations or search and rescue operations.
- (b) *Intelligence activities exception*. The prohibitions of $\underline{40.203}$ do not apply to any activity subject to the reporting requirements under title V of the National Security Act of 1947 ($\underline{50~U.S.C.~3091}$ et seq.), any authorized intelligence activities of the United States, or any activity or procurement that supports an authorized intelligence activity.
- (c) $Tribal\ law\ enforcement\ or\ emergency\ service\ agency\ exception.$ The prohibitions in 40.203 do not apply to $Tribal\ law\ enforcement\ or\ Tribal\ emergency\ service\ agencies\ to\ the\ extent\ that\ an authorized\ official\ at\ the\ agency,\ in\ consultation\ with\ the\ Secretary\ of\ Homeland\ Security,\ determines\ that\ the\ procurement\ or\ operation\ is\ necessary\ for\ the\ purposes\ of\ supporting\ the\ full\ range\ of\ law\ enforcement\ operations\ or\ search\ and\ rescue\ operations\ on\ Indian\ lands.$
